**Bring:** Your camera, memory cards (try to empty this so you're starting with a blank card) and batteries as needed, comfortable shoes, weather appropriate clothing (we're going rain or shine), and some cash to buy lunch (many inexpensive options are close by).

**Length of walk:** We'll be very user-friendly. We'll have different groups with both short and longer walks available. Maps will be distributed.
